This week we looked at the story of Cain and Abel, Enoch, as well as part of the story of Noah. Work through the following questions to help you review and think through our verses.

Genesis 4:1-16

1. Adam and Eve began to fulfill the command to be fruitful and multiply. We are not presented any details of their life until a very sad event. From the story of Cain and Abel, what had their parents taught them to do?
2. On into the Bible, we are told there are various types of sacrifices that were acceptable to the Lord. Animal and grain offerings were accepted. What do you think was the problem with Cain's sacrifice?
3. After the Lord's rebuke of Cain, what did he not do?
4. What does the phrase from God, "sin is crouching at the door" mean?
5. Since the Lord knew Cain's heart in the sacrifice Cain made, why do you think Cain thought he could fool God about the murder of Abel?
6. How did the Lord both punish Cain and show Cain grace?

Genesis 5:18-24

1. One of the most fascinating events in the Bible occurs in Enoch's life. He walked with God and the Lord took him. What do you think it means to "walk" with God?

Genesis 6:5-7:24 - Noah

1. What was God's description of mankind at this point?
2. What does Noah teach us about the possibility of living a godly life in the midst of a sinful world?
3. How did Noah demonstrate faith?

4. How is the story of Noah and the Ark a picture of our salvation through Jesus?
