"One Leper's Story"
Luke 17:11-19

Today's message will be in the manner of a dramatic monologue. A dramatic monologue seeks to tell the story of a figure in a personal way. The presentation will tell the story from Luke 17 about ten lepers who were healed. Only one came back to praise and thank Jesus. The one leper's story is full of lessons. Do know, the monologue tells the story in the scripture, along with elements of what life may have been like for this leper. Ultimately, the story is of a man whose life was transformed by Jesus. A story leading us to see how each one needs Jesus' transforming work within.

Luke 17:11-19

- 11 While traveling to Jerusalem, He passed between Samaria and Galilee.
- 12 As He entered a village, 10 men with serious skin diseases met Him. They stood at a distance,
- 13 and raised their voices, saying, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!"
- 14 When He saw them, He told them, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." And while they were going, they were healed. 15 But one of them, seeing that he was healed, returned and, with a loud voice, gave glory to God.
- 16 He fell facedown at His feet, thanking Him. And he was a Samaritan.
- 17 Then Jesus said, "Were not 10 cleansed? Where are the nine?
- 18 Didn't any return to give glory to God except this foreigner?"
- 19 And He told him, "Get up and go on your way. Your faith has made you well."
