Week 16 Review



Week 16 covered Acts 20 through 21:25. The stories range from a boy falling out of a window while Paul spoke, to the heartbreaking scene as Paul left friends from Ephesus. Let's review.

Acts 20:1-12

1. What do you find as a crazy event in verses 1-12?
2. After Eutychus was brought back to life and all knew he was ok, what did Paul start doing? V.11
3. Vs. 13-38 - what are two or three things that Paul talked about with the Ephesian elders that stand out to you?

Acts 21:1-25

1. Where have we seen Philip in Acts previously?
2. What reaction did the people have to Agabus' words? What was Paul's reaction?
3. Verses 15-25- Paul arrives in Jerusalem and immediately must respond to accusations that Paul was telling Jews not to follow laws of Moses. Of course, Paul taught them they didn't need to follow the law of Moses to be saved - but if they wanted to keep certain laws for conscience sake, go ahead. Paul sets an example by helping these 4 men with their vow. Why was Paul willing to submit to the Jerusalem church leaders request?
