- 6. What did Naomi ask the people of Bethlehem to call her when she returned, and why? What does the name Naomi mean? And Mara? Why did she want people to call her Mara?
- 7. When did Naomi and Ruth arrive in Bethlehem? (What season?)

- 1. Who was Boaz, and how was he related to Naomi?
- 2. What did Ruth ask Naomi's permission to do when they arrived in Bethlehem?
- 3. How did Ruth end up gleaning in Boaz's field?
- 4. How did Boaz treat Ruth when he first met her?
- 5. What did Boaz know about Ruth's character and actions?
- 6. What blessing did Boaz speak over Ruth in Ruth 2:12?
- 7. How did Ruth respond to Boaz's kindness?
- 8. What do you learn about God's character from the way He provides for Naomi and Ruth?
- 9. How does Ruth's loyalty to Naomi challenge or encourage you in your own relationships?
- 10. In what ways does Boaz's kindness reflect God's love?
