Week 1 Review**



Off we go into a new reading plan that will cover August-December 2025. The month of August will be 1 John. Let's review our first week's reading: 1 John 1-2:17.

1 John 1

1. According to 1 John 1:1-4, what was the main message John wants to share about Jesus? (*Hint: Think about what John says that he has seen, heard, and touched.*)
2. V.4 What is the joy John refers to?
3. What does it mean to "walk in darkness"? What does it mean to "walk in the light"?
4. We that are truly saved are no longer to seek to go after sin, to practice sin with no conviction. However, we know we all stumble in sin at times. What is the promise given to the Christian who does sin? (1 John 1:8-10)
5. According to 1 John 2:1-2, who is our advocate with the Father, and what does He do for us?
6. What is the evidence that someone truly knows God, according to 1 John 2:3-6? Does this mean our works keep us saved or our obedience shows we are?

7. How does John describe the commandment to love one another in 1 John 2:7-11? How is the command both old and new?
8. What does John say about those who claim to be in the light but hate their brother or sister? (1 John 2:9-11)
9. In 1 John 2:12-14, John addresses different groups, levels of Christian maturity (children, fathers, young men). What are some of the spiritual truths he affirms about each group?
10. 1 John 2:15-17 - What does the “world” referring to in these verses?
11. What is the danger of loving the world more than the Father?
12. According to 1 John 2:16, what are the three things in the world that are not from the Father?
13. 1 John 2:17 - what is the promise for those who do the will of the Father?

Let's examine our heart and let the Holy Spirit show us any matter about the “world” that that is drawing our love for Jesus away.
