1.	What is the name commonly given to Jesus' teaching in Matthew 5-7?
2.	Why do you think the first "beatitude" is about being poor in spirit? What does being poor in spirit mean?
3.	What does Jesus call His followers in relation to the world (two metaphors)?
4.	How did Jesus fulfill all the law and prophets' words?
5.	The righteousness of the Pharisees was outer. Jesus tells us we need an inner transformation. How is inner transformation possible?
6.	These words about anger, murder, adultery, lust is to show that it is not mere outward acts that we should be concerned about. Sin is in the heart, so everyone needs made right with God.
7.	What does Jesus teach about divorce?
8.	What command does Jesus give regarding our enemies?
