Our scripture passages for this week included mostly parables from chapter 13. Chapter 14 gives us the tough story about John the Baptist. Let's review.

Matthew 13-14:12

- 1. What is the main message of the Parable of the Sower in Matthew 13:1-23, and what do the different types of soil represent?
- 2. In the Parable of the Weeds (Matthew 13:24-30, 36-43), who sows the good seed, and who sows the weeds? What do the harvest and the reapers represent?
- 3. What do the mustard seed and the yeast (leaven) represent in the parables Jesus tells in Matthew 13:31-33?
- 4. Why did Jesus speak to the crowds in parables, according to Matthew 13:10-17?
- 5. In Matthew 13:44-46, Jesus tells the parables of the hidden treasure and the pearl. What do these parables teach about the value of the kingdom of heaven?
- 6. What is the meaning of the Parable of the Net (Matthew 13:47-50), and what does it teach about the end of the age?

7.	How did the people of Jesus' hometown respond to His teaching in Matthew 13:53-58, and what was the result?
8.	Who was Herod the tetrarch, and why was he troubled by reports about Jesus in Matthew 14:1-2?
9.	Why had John the Baptist been imprisoned by Herod, according to Matthew 14:3-5?
10. Describe the events that led to the death of John the Baptist in Matthew 14:6-12. Who was involved, and what was the outcome?
