Here are a number of review questions from our scripture passages for the week, Matthew 10:26-11:30.

Matthew 10:26-39

- What reasons does Jesus give for not being afraid of those who oppose the disciples?
- How does Jesus describe God's care for His followers in these verses?
- What does it mean to "acknowledge" or "deny" Jesus before others?
- What does Jesus mean when He says, "Whoever does not take up their cross and follow me is not worthy of me"?
- In what ways might following Jesus cause conflict in personal relationships?

Matthew 10:

- How does Jesus describe the connection between Himself, those He sends, and those who receive them?

- What is the significance of giving “a cup of cold water” to one of Jesus’ followers?

Matthew 11:1-6

- Why does John the Baptist send messengers to Jesus, and what question do they ask?
- How does Jesus respond to John’s question, and what does this reveal about His identity and mission?

Matthew 11:7-19

- How does Jesus describe John the Baptist’s role and significance?
- What does Jesus mean by saying, “the least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he”?

Matthew 11:20-30

- What does this passage teach about the responsibility that comes with witnessing God’s works?
- What does Jesus reveal about the Father and those to whom the truth is revealed?
- What invitation does Jesus extend in verses 28–30, and what does He promise to those who come to Him?
- How does Jesus describe His heart and the “yoke” He offers?
