- 4. In Matthew 19: 3-9, what question do the Pharisees ask Jesus about divorce, and how does He respond? (Matthew 19:3-9)
- 5. (Matthew 19:13-15) What does Jesus say about children and the kingdom of heaven?
- 6. (Matthew 19:16-22) What challenge does Jesus give to the rich young ruler, and what is the ruler's response?
