Matthew 26:6-16

- 2. How did Jesus interpret the woman's act, and what promise did He make concerning her?(how has the promise been kept?)
- 3. When have you witnessed or offered an act of extravagant love or worship to God, even when others didn't understand? What holds you back from giving your best to Jesus?

Matthew 26:17-30

- 1. What were the disciples preparing for, and why was it significant?
- 2. What does Jesus mean when He says, "This is my body... this is my blood"?

3.	How do you personally remember and participate in what Jesus did at the Last Supper? What does communion mean to you today?
Matthew 26:36-46	
1.	How did Jesus pray in the Garden of Gethsemane, and what did He ask of His disciples?
2.	What do you observe about Jesus' emotional and spiritual struggle in this passage?
3.	How do you respond when God's will seems difficult or costly? What does Jesus' prayer teach you about handling moments of deep distress?
Matthew 26:57-75	
1.	What accusations were brought against Jesus before the council?
2.	How did Peter react when he was confronted about knowing Jesus, and why? How did each denial grow in intensity?
3.	When have you felt pressure to hide your faith? How can Peter's experience help you remain faithful even when it's hard?
Matthew 27:15-26	
1.	Why did the crowd choose Barabbas over Jesus, and what was Pilate's reaction?
2.	What symbolic act did Pilate perform, and what did it mean?
3.	How do you respond to situations where going along with the crowd is the easier option, even if it's wrong? How can you stand for what's right?
