

## Gospel Of Matthew Bible Reading Plan Week 15 Review

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Week 15 concluded our reading through the Gospel of Matthew. We began with Matthew 27:27 and went through Matthew 28. A couple of notes: One, every fall we will have one of the gospels to read through. This is a regular part of our plan. Two, the new reading plan will be placed out soon. In 2026 we will read through 1 and 2 Samuel, 1 and 2 Peter, Micah, and the Gospel of Luke. Let's review our final passages from Matthew.

### Matthew 27:27- 28:20

1. Describe how the soldiers mocked and abused Jesus before the crucifixion.  
(Matt. 27:27–31)
2. What were some of the supernatural or unusual events that occurred during Jesus' crucifixion and at His death? (Matt. 27:45–54)
3. How did the Roman centurion and those with him respond after witnessing Jesus' death? (Matt. 27:54)
4. Who requested Jesus' body for burial, and what precautions were taken by the authorities at the tomb?  
(Matt. 27:57–66)
5. Who were the first people to discover the empty tomb, and what message did the angel give them?  
(Matt. 28:1–7)

6. How did the chief priests and elders respond to the guards' report, and what story did they spread? (Matt. 28:11–15) Why do some people reject the evidence for Jesus even when it is clear, and how can we lovingly respond to their doubts?
7. When Jesus appeared to the disciples in Galilee, what command did He give them? What does this command mean for us today?  
(Matt. 28:18–20) How are you living out Jesus' commission to make disciples where you are?
8. What promise did Jesus give his followers as He sent them out into the world? (Matt. 28:20) How does remembering Jesus' presence give you courage or purpose in your daily life?
